HORSE-DRAWN-TRAM FACTS

- The daily Horse Drawn Tram service is the only all-year operation of its kind in the world.
- The tram travels across the 630 metre causeway throughout the day taking passengers to picturesque Granite Island.
- The current trams were built in 1986, based on the original tram design but extended by two windows to give extra headroom.
- When the Horses are not working, they graze on pasture on the banks of the Inman River, 4km inland.
- A working Clydesdale weighs 800 1000kg, but only needs to place 80kg of weight to start the tram rolling and occasional 15 kg tugs to keep it rolling.
- The trams weigh 4³/₄ tonnes tare and 8¹/₂ tonnes fully loaded carrying approximately 40 people. They use roller bearings to minimize rolling effort.
- The Tramway originally commenced carrying passengers from Victor Harbor to Granite Island in 1894 by the South Australia Railways and ran until 1954. After being tractorised, it was relaunched in 1986 as part of the South Australian state's 150th anniversary of settlement jubilee.
