Each year, the Victor Harbor region welcomes one of nature's most awe-inspiring spectacles—the migration of Southern Right Whales to the stunning waters of the Fleurieu Peninsula. The Winter Whale Fest is a month-long celebration dedicated to these majestic marine visitors, offering a memorable opportunity to connect with the ocean, learn from leading conservationists, and immerse yourself in an unforgettable program of cultural, educational, and nature-based experiences.
